Please note the following about the easing of restrictions:

Attending church services – we understand that the legal restrictions on our worship environment are now largely being lifted. We will still be encouraging all attendees to wear face masks. We are conscious that some people will want to observe social distancing. We respect this and will ensure there is space. Generally, we will proceed with caution, and continue to look out for one another.

Singing – we are now free to sing inside our buildings, and our services will include opportunities to do so. Please do join in if you feel able to do so. Please do keep your mask on for singing; (we will keep this aspect of the easing under review.) If you would rather not sing, or observe extra distance when singing, there should be plenty of space to do this.

Communion – for now, the sharing of communion, will stay the same as it has been during the pandemic. We are now free to physically share the peace, but please only do so when you know both parties are happy to do so.
